
Reinvent vourself to discover who you really are


Aquatic games and water obstacle course

Megève, an amazing land of horses

The 25 horse-drawn carriages taking pride of place around the village square are more than a symbol of folklore, they are the perfect example of a unique farming tradition and heritage. Each coachman is primarily a farmer although many of them are also horse breeders. In fact, their "right to a space" cannot be sold but is instead passed down through the generations like a family heirloom! This equine history is clearly evidenced in a very special and unique breed of local horse called "Le cheval de Megève", which is the perfect cross-breed of a Franche-Montagne and a Comtois horse. Other examples of this history are the Concours aux Poulains (Colts & Fillies Competition) an institution with a 150 year history, which will be held this year on 5 August, and the only international showjumping competition in the world to be set in the mountains - Jumping International de Megève - which will take place between 18 and 23 July. Proof that in Megève, a horse is man's best friend!
